Sir,

I am directed to refer to your proposal on the subject mentioned above seeking permission of the Central Govt. for starting/increase of seats in various Postgraduate courses at Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur, Rajasthan under Section 10(A) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

2. After careful consideration of the scheme and taking into consideration the recommendations of Medical Council of India in this regard, this Ministry has come to a conclusion that a letter for starting/increase of seats in the following postgraduate course(s) with intake of students mentioned against each course from the academic session 2016-17 at your college under Section 10 (A) of IMC Act may be issued for obtaining certain essential documents required for issuance of Letter of Permission (LoP):

Starting:

1. MD (Radio Therapy) : 1(One)

Increase:

1. MD (Radio Diagnosis) : 5(Five) to 7(Seven)
2. MD (General Medicine) : 7(Seven) to 12(Twelve)
3. MD (Paediatrics) : 3(Three) to 6(Six)
4. MS (Ophthalmology) : 1(One) to 2(Two)


3. Therefore it is requested to furnish the following documents/undertaking/acceptance of conditions to the Ministry:-

- (i) The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings. Equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.
- (ii) No student should be admitted in the above course till the formal permission of the Central Govt. is granted.
- (iii) The Private Medical College should provide **Bank Guarantee of required amount wherever required in favour of Medical Council of India, New Delhi valid for three years from a nationalized/scheduled Bank as per MCI's norms.** However, medical colleges/institutions governed by the State Govt. are required to furnish only an undertaking to provide funds in their plan budget till the facilities are fully provided as per time bound programme indicated by them.
- (iv) The Medical Colleges/institutions will provide undertaking to implement the decision regarding payment of stipend to the PG students similar to PG students of Govt. medical colleges in their State.
- (v) The Govt. Medical College(s) (except those colleges located in Andhra Pradesh, Telangana & J&K) should give an undertaking authorising Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India to include 50% of PG (Medical) seats in All India Quota PG seats for the year 2016.

4. Action to grant formal permission of the Central Govt. for starting/increase of seats in the said course at your college will be initiated on receipt of a compliance report fulfilling the conditions enumerated in paragraph 3 above. **The Bank Guarantee/undertaking may be sent immediately to enable the Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for the year 2016-17.**


